From 1962-66, 845 and other Naval helicopter squadrons, were sent to Borneo as part of a Royal Navy taskforce to support the Malaysian government during their confrontation with Indonesian communists. The daring flying in support of the soldiers fighting in the jungle earned the commando squadron pilots and support personnel the nickname "Junglies". During the dinner, the history and heritage of how the Junglies earned their name and reputation will be described and explained by members of 845 Naval Air Squadron that have recently visited Borneo to tread in the footsteps of their predecessors.
