The Royal Navy has been flying aircraft from ships at sea for over 100 years and its collection of flying historic aircraft are some of the rarest and most historically significant naval aircraft in the world.

From the daring and heroic actions of the Royal Naval Air Service in the First World War to the new Queen Elizabeth aircraft carriers and F35 Lightning II fighter, the Royal Navy's aviation heritage is a story of pioneering achievement, courage and technological innovation that led the world.

The Fly Navy Heritage Trust was formed in 1991 to promote the history, ethos and spirit of naval aviation and to preserve and protect the nation's naval aviation heritage. At the core of the Trust's mission is the need to raise over £700,000 a year to keep the Royal Navy's historic aircraft flying, bringing the story of naval flying to life in an exciting and dynamic way to millions of people at air shows and events around the country.

The Royal Navy's historic aircraft represent a golden thread linking the past with the future. From the Fairey Swordfish bi-plane, one of the greatest aircraft in the history of naval warfare, through to the Hawker Sea Fury, the last of the piston engine fighters of the 1950s; and the Hawker Sea Hawk representing the Fleet Air Arm's entry into jet-age

carrier aviation, the flying collection provides a powerful educational link between the Royal Navy's historic past and the future.

Additionally the Trust, through its subsidiary company, Naval Aviation Ltd, also supports a Sea Fury T20 and Sea Vixen maintained on the civil register. Together these magnificent aircraft are an enduring legacy and living memorial to the service and sacrifice of all those who gave their lives in the service of naval aviation.
