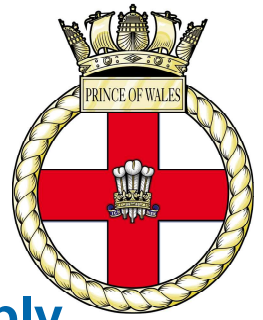

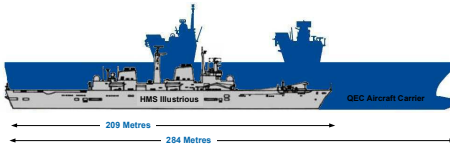

Block Transportation and Ship Assembly



- Largest surface warships to ever enter service with the Royal Navy
- Length: 284m ≈ 90m longer than the existing aircraft carrier.
- Generate enough energy to power 300,000 kettles or 5,500 family homes (a town the size of Swindon).
- 65,000 tonnes at full displacement = over three times the size of the current Invincible Class Aircraft Carriers (CVS).



Bow Section Already Docked at Rosyth from Appleby

- Flightdeck: 283m x 69m ≈ approx 3 standard rugby pitches.
- Range: 8,000 to 10,000 nautical miles.
- 1,740km of Fibre Optic cable: enough to link London to Gibraltar.



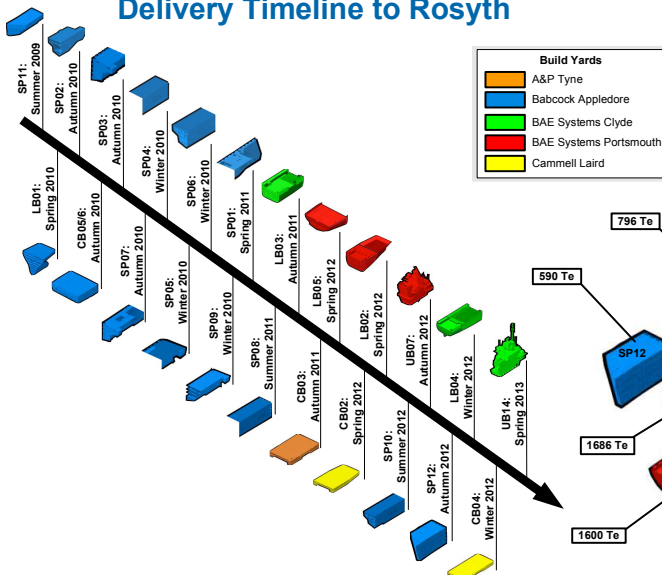
Goliath Crane Ready for Action at Rosyth

- Crew: Ship's Company of 760 + Embarked Sqns & Staffs = 1600.
- Bulbous bow weighs more than 33 double decker buses
- Keel to Masthead: 56m ≈ 6m taller than Nelson's Column.
